FRBW2	Chablis, Domaine Pico Race Crisp and fresh with aromas of apples with underlying minerality and balancing acidity.	£12.27
FRBW3	Pouilly Fuisse, Domaine du Capucins, Macon The colour is a brilliant yellow. The aroma is a powerful, with hints of peach and apricot. In the mouth, fruity and floral with great structure.	£17.21
FRBW4	Chablis 1er Cru “Mont de Milieu” Domaine Emile Petit This classy 1er Cru from the South facing slopes overlooking the village of Chichee has great depth and minerality with a crisp dry finish.	£19.39

FRBR2	Gevrey Chambertin, Domaine Drouhin Laroze - Burgundy I suppose this could be regarded as House Wine to Drouhin Laroze with the rest of the cellar consisting of only Grand and 1er Crus! However Phillippe takes the same care over crafting this bottle which results in text book Gevrey Chambertin. Full and ripe with backbone and structure, the wine is ideal for current consumption.	£30.43

FRRW1	Chateauneuf du Pape Blanc, Chateau de la Gardine Memories of Provence! This crisp, fresh, unoaked white made mainly from Grenache Blanc just oozes aromas and flavours of the South of France. A nose of white blossom and white fruits is mirrored on the palate with a refreshing acidity.	£25.15

FRRR1	Crozes Hermitage Rouge, Domaine des Entrefaux Fantastic Crozes loaded with raspberry and liquorice flavours that offer a powerful and rich, chocolatey finish. Great value!	£12.22
FRRR2	Cotes du Rhone, Domaine de la Sarriette A simple appellation with excellent quantity, deeply coloured from Syrah and Grenache giving real warmth and flavour.	£8.22

FRLR1	Sancerre Rose, Domaine Brochard Pure Pinot Noir. Light and fruity with gorgeous berry notes and flavours. Serve slightly chilled but not too much. Great anytime.	£13.29
FRLW1	Muscadet Sur Lie, Chateau de la Ragotiere This is a benchmark example, very clean and correct with citrus undertones to the inviting bouquet. Persistent and fruity, the wine is a superb partner to shellfish and white fish or ideal as an aperitif.

FRBOR1	St Emilion, Chateau Haut Giraudon Loads of sweet raspberry and blackcurrant fruit in this earthy St. Emilion. Good complexity and a terrific aftertaste. Great with grilled meat.	£7.92
FRBOR2	Chateau du Grand Pierre, 1er Cotes de Blaye This vineyard situated across the estuary from Margaux has clay and chalk hillsides perfectly suited for the Merlot grape, which dominates the blend. Soft ripe tannins give way to rich fruit qualities from partial ageing in oak.	£7.53

SPWH1	Torre Abalde Blanco, Dominio de Eguren The colour is very bright, clean yellow with greenish hues. It has a fresh fruit aroma with hints of banana, apple and peach. In the mouth it shows fresh fruity, silky notes with bright acidity, followed by a fruity strong finish.	£5.69
SPWH2	Albillo, Ribera del Duero, Bodegas Valduero Deep elegant fruit with hints of pineapple with a nuance of herbaceous tones. Fabulous balance of fruit and acidity.	£7.77
SPWH3	Organza, Rioja Blanco, Sierra Cantabria This stunning white Rioja has been barrel fermented in the new French oak to give a rich and expansive style. The nose opens with aromas of tropical fruit which develop quickly to allow the minerality of the terroir to shine through. On the palate it is fresh, round and powerful with a silky finish.	£15.23

SPRED1	Rioja Crianza, Sierra Cantabria A clean and bright ruby-red colour with light but intense tones. Ripe fruit aromas, well balanced with complex spicy notes and elegant vanilla tones that persist. Sturdy tannins on the palate, rounded and well structured with presence of ripe fruits, Cocoa and coffee and red berry aromas. Complex with excellent harmony.	£8.98
SPRED2	Rioja Reserva, Bodegas Valgrande From the estate at the heart of La Rioja Alta, the vineyards are 500m above sea level with Tempranillo dominating. The wine is aged in American oak to give subtle vanilla and jammy flavours with a lasting and smooth finish.	£12.03

SPRED3	Ribera Del Duero Crianza, Bodegas Valduero A well-rounded wine, cherry red in colour. Good in the olfactory passage and improving on the nose. With tones of oak, vanilla and spices. A well-balanced and well-structured wine with a slightly astringent taste which gives a hint of its age and suggests a long life with further development both on the palate and with time.	£12.03

ITWH1	Trebbiano D'Abruzzo - Taverna Nova Pale yellow colour with green reflections. On the nose a fruity aroma and in the mouth very harmonious and tasty.	£8.10

ITRED1	Chianti Colli Senesi, Tenuta Mormoraia - Tuscany Vivid ruby-red in colour with a distinctive sour-cherry fruitiness. The delicate and Noble rich taste of this dry wine enhances with age and is indicative of its maturity, as is the blackberry aroma. In its early years this wine is appreciated with all kinds of food.	£8.80

AUSW3	Riesling, Hollick – Coonawarra A distinctive wine with intense floral aromas with lemon and lime characteristics, balanced by a cleansing acid finish.	£9.80

AUSRE1	Shiraz / Cabernet, Bottle Tree - South East Bursting with blackcurrants, the palate displays subtle pepper and cinnamon spice with a well rounded finish from maturation with American oak.	£6.59
AUSRE2	Shiraz, Rams Leap – New South Wales Dark red cherry colour with purple hints; blackberry and cherry aromas with hints of chocolate and cinnamon followed by plum and spice on the palate.	£9.04
AUSRE3	Pinot Noir, Trentham – Murray River Aromas of cherry and strawberry with a hint of toasty oak. The palate is medium bodied and features Pinot Noir's typically silky mouthfeel.	£9.86
